How to get involved (3)

- Fit project idea into Work Programme
- Emphasise project's goal, necessity and advantages in a European context
- Involve partners with Framework Programme experience
- Get involved in writing of your Work Package or Task(s)
- Clarify your role and ensure that your expertise is fully utilised

Communicate well to show your commitment

Working in Consortium (1)

Suitable combination of partners

- Long-term friendship is not the best reference for cooperation on international project
- Complementarity between the partners
- Size of Consortium – depends on nature of the project
- Balancing the consortium (industrial vs academic partners, technology/knowledge users vs providers, gender issues, member states vs associated/third countries,...)

Working in Consortium (2)

Due diligence – checking on potential partners

- Successful participation in previous projects
- Experience in the proposed work area
- Financial viability

Co-ordinate when....

- Organization has multinational project management experience
- Organization has a suitable Project Manager
- Organization is established for several years and is financially secure
- Organization has previously participated in an EU project (*not mandatory if it is a major world player and of sufficient size and stature*)

HOWEVER, As a 1st Time participant in the Programme – Coordination is not advisable

- Among *existing international business/technical contacts*, forums, international industrial/trade associations
- Among the participants to *Thematic Information Days*
- Among the *Partners of existing projects*
- Through *National Contact Points (NCP)* in Targetted Countries
- Participation in *European Technology Platforms*

PS tool - CORDIS



- Is an on-line tool for partner search
- Allows you to search partners from EU, third countries including India
- Connects with 1000's of active partnerships across the globe (Companies, Research Companies, Institutions & Universities)

- Search the partner profiles submitted by other organizations



- Developed report on Indian Environment Sector
- Mapped Indian research potential with EU priorities & developed a contact repository of 1500 Indian environment organizations
- Developed an On-line Indian Environment Sector Partner Search Tool
- More than 600 Indian organizations' details available in this Partner Search Tool
- Purpose: To facilitate European organizations to search for Indian potential collaborators in FP7 projects

Data Collection and Analysis

- The mapped organizations consists of 62% academic players, 21% research institutes, 14% NGOs and 3% Private Firms.
- All the 4 categories of organizations have portrayed direct or indirect research interest and capacity on global issues like climate change, renewable energy and innovative, clean technology development.
- Environmental R&D in India is mainly driven by government funding. The government schemes facilitates building infrastructure and sponsors projects.
